

Description of Categorical, Bilingual, and Migrant Education Programs

Title I, Part A

Title I, Part A is a federally funded program authorized under the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) of 2001. It provides supplemental funds to help improve instruction in high poverty schools to ensure all students meet state academic standards. The school-wide Title I program allows the school to use these funds to engage in reform strategies that increase the amount and quality of learning and help provide high-quality curriculum for all students. As directed by the California Department of Education (CDE), the school focuses its use of Title I funds on students (including English learners and students with disabilities) who are not meeting proficiency on the state standards. These students are Far Below Basic, Below Basic, and Basic on the California Standards Tests (CSTs).

Economic Impact Aid-Limited English Proficient (EIA-LEP)

EIA-LEP is a state categorical program that provides supplemental funds to support additional programs and services for English learners. The use of EIA-LEP funds are designed to assist English learners achieve proficiency in the English language. Allowable expenditures may include the purchase of supplemental materials and expenses that support paraprofessionals, supplemental resource teachers, and the operation of EL advisory committees. EIA-LEP funds shall supplement and not supplant existing resources at the school site.

Title III, Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient Students (LEP)

The purpose of the Title III LEP student program is to ensure that all limited-English proficient (LEP) students, or English learners, attain English proficiency, develop high levels of academic attainment in English, and meet the same challenging state academic standards as all other students. Title III LEP funds must be used for the following supplementary services as part of the language instruction program for LEP students:

- English language development instruction
- Enhanced instruction in the core academic subjects
- High-quality professional development for teachers and other staff

Migrant Education

Students qualify for this district-wide supplemental program if they have changed residences within the past three years so that a member of the immediate family could secure seasonal or temporary employment in agriculture, the fishing industry, or related food processing. The funds are used to provide tutoring in graduation requirements in school programs. The program may provide teachers, instructional aides, tutors, and counselors to assist these students. Annual dental and health check-up services are also provided.

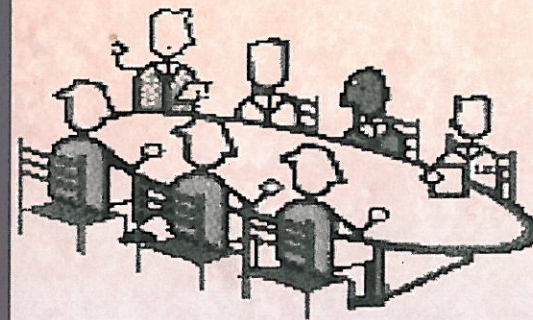
